The photo work "I AM" was photographed in the suburbs of Accra, Ghana.

Contrary to the common black and white journalism of "catastrophes" this work tries to show a positiv surreal picture of West Africa.

The photo shoots were made with an analog panorama camera (visual angle of 180°). By using this special camera the mostly small rooms are opened for the observer.

By the individual movements of the photographed africans, which will be captured by the length of exposure, no posed positions or gesture are shown.

This is in contrast to the classical West African studio-photography.
